## **Mom's Christmas Cookies**

Great fun to make especially when young ones are around to decorate the cookies after they are baked.

This recipe came from Ginnie Goheen and will always be remembered as a Christmas favorite. Sometimes the decorated cookies were made with a hole at the top for a ribbon so that they could be hung on trees. Makes about 5 dozen cookies.

Quantity	Ingredients		Preparation Notes
1/3 Cup	Soft Shortening (margarine)	•)	Cream shortening and sugar.
1/3 Cup	Sugar	•)	Mix in egg and honey or molasses
1	Egg	•)	Add baking soda, salt, cinnamon and ginger.
2/3 Cup	Honey or light molasses	•)	Mix in flour
2 3/4	Flour	•)	Chill dough at least 1 hour
Cup	rioui	•)	Roll out thick (about 1/4 inch)
1 tsp	Baking Soda	•)	Cut into shapes and place on lightly greased
1 tsp	Salt		cookie sheet about 1 inch apart.
2 tsp	Cinnamon	•)	Bake in preheated oven at 350 degrees until no imprint remains when touched.
1 tsp	Ginger	<ul><li>)</li><li>)</li></ul>	Cool Ice and decorate.
